<p>Develop and implement projects that will enhance the immediate environment of the Market Place and of the wider town.</p>	<p>The company will work to deliver an improved environment in Higher Buxton and in the wider Buxton area, and develop and fund projects aimed at promoting better linkage between the disparate areas of the town. This will encourage a sense of 'One Town' and strengthen community spirit.</p>
<p>Operate in collaboration with other organisations in the town who share similar objectives.</p>	<p>The company will collaborate with High Peak Borough Council and the Pavilion Gardens, so as to offer a mutually supportive programme of fairs and markets, with other voluntary organisations in the town, with local businesses and with individuals in the community who have similar or related objectives.</p>


